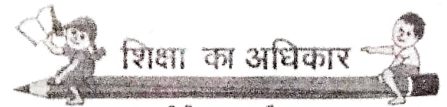

## Celebration of Republic Day

### Quiz, Essay and Patriotic Poetry Competitions on MyGov.in platform

1. On the occasion of celebrating the "Republic day" on 26<sup>th</sup> January, Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education in association with Ministry of Defence has decided to conduct online quiz competitions, essay competition (maximum 1500 words) and poetry competition (maximum 100 words) for children through MyGov platform.

**Theme** : Indian Constitution, struggle for freedom and warriors of Indian independence.

**Duration** : 20<sup>th</sup> January to 30<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

2. Objective: Celebration of this occasion annually helps youth and children of the country to be aware of the significance of Indian Constitution, unity and integrity of this great nation and also provides an opportunity to everyone to be patriotic towards their great nation endowed with rich and varied heritage.
3. The competitions can be accessed at the link mygov.in.
4. Participants who get all answers right shall automatically receive an online certificate from Director NCERT through My Gov platform.
5. Selection of top 5 entries among participants of essay and poetry competitions will first be done at the State/ UT level by the respective SCERT and the same will be transmitted by Email to NCERT for final selection of top 10 entries at the National level.
6. Registration Process: For entering the above competitions, the following **mandatory** information will be required from the participants on My Gov
  - a. Name of participant
  - b. Studying in class
  - c. Age
  - d. Name of school
  - e. Address of school
  - f. State/UT in which school is located (drop down option)
  - g. Mobile number and email id of self/parent/guardian
